1. Information about the RSC & using this website

- 1.1 The Royal Shakespeare Company (**the RSC or we**) welcomes you to www.rsc.org.uk (**our website**). For further details about the RSC, please go to the end of these terms of use.
- 1.2 This page and any documents referred to on it tell you how you can use our website (**terms of use**). Please read these terms carefully before you start to use our website, since by using this website, you indicate that you accept the terms.
- 1.3 Please note that some services offered on our website are subject to additional terms and conditions that supplement or vary these terms of use. Where additional terms apply, it will be clearly stated on the appropriate webpage.
